Dear Parents

The **R-5 Swimming Carnival** will be held on **Friday 1 April** at the **Unley Swimming Centre**. Students will be transported by bus, leaving school at 9:15am. Reception and Year 1 classes will return to school by bus at 1:00pm and the Year 2, 3, 4 and 5 classes will return to school at 2:30pm. All Students are required to be at school as normal and travel with their class to the pool.

Students should wear their PE uniform and or a house coloured t-shirt to school with their bathers underneath. Bathers and a rash top must be worn to ensure protection from the sun during the carnival. Please pack a towel, thongs, hat, windcheater, underwear and sun block (all named) into their school bag to take to the pool. A plastic bag to put wet clothes in after they swim is also a good idea.

Each student will need to bring their own recess, lunch and a drink bottle as they will not be permitted to buy from the canteen on the day. The canteen will be an out of bounds area for students.

Students will sit with their Class Teacher throughout the day. We would greatly appreciate help with dressing the children especially at the end of the carnival.

The first event will consist of the stronger swimmers competing in the 25 metre events in the main pool, swimming across the pool. Students who participate in the 25 metre events will be awarded with a ribbon. Students who are capable of **CONFIDENTLY** swimming 25 metres in the shallow end of an Olympic size pool are invited to fill in and return the attached form as soon as possible so the programme can be finalised. This will enable students to experience the thrill of taking part or seeing their classmates swim. The 25 metre events will commence at approximately 10:00am. There will also be an opportunity for Year 3, 4 and 5 students to swim in 50m events. They will need to make a choice of distance as they have to choose either 25m or 50m for each event.

Throughout the day all students will be given an opportunity to swim in the middle pool for their novelty events.

Please note that the Reception and Year 1 Students will return to the College at 1:00pm. Students will have time to eat their lunch when they return to the College

We look forward to an enjoyable day together and encourage you to attend. We do however, ask that students stay with their class groups and do not wander away to sit with parents. We know that this can be difficult at times to enforce and would appreciate your help in returning any Students immediately back to their class area.
